

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1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 General

With 110 million inhabitants (census 2017), Punjab is by far the most populated province in Pakistan. Punjab is Pakistan's second largest province by area after Baluchistan with an area of 205,344 square kilometers (79,284 square miles). It occupies 25.8% of the total landmass of Pakistan. Punjab has nine divisions as shown in map below and 36 districts.

The Punjab Cities Program (PCP), is a World Bank-funded hybrid of Program for Results (P for R) and Investment Project Financing (IPF) operation, with total cost of USD 200 million over 5 years (2018 -2023) supporting 16 cities in Punjab. Its development objective is to strengthen the performance of participating Municipal Committees/Corporations (MCs), focusing on urban management and improvement of municipal infrastructure for satisfactory service delivery.

Depending on geographical locations, 16 selected cities have been divided in 3 zones detailed hereunder:

Northern Zone -

Central Zone -

Municipal services sub projects are planned in these 16 cities in various sectors including solid waste management, Roads, Cross roads, street lights, and Parks.

The project has been targeted in five different sectors i.e. Rehabilitation of Municipal Services of Infrastructure, Solid Waste Management Roads and street lights, Crossroad, Chowks, Important Nodes, and Parks with different type of services to be given by consultant.

2 PROCESS FOR SELECTION OF CONTRACTORS:

2.1 Evaluation Committee

As per Consultants TOR's, technical evaluation of bids was conducted by M/s Jers Consultancy as per the specified criteria and the results are being formulated in this report for further scrutiny of this report by the evaluation committee members constituted by Concerned MC.

2.2 Advertisement

A notice inviting the Bidders for the project "Construction of SWM Parking Area in MC Hafizabad" was circulated by MC Jhang to invite Eligible Bidders was published in widely circulated national newspaper (Annexure-A) and the bid proposals were opened on 23-05-2023 at 11:30 AM in the presence of procurement committee representatives.

2.3 Short listing of Eligible Bidders

For the short listing of eligible Bidders the proposal/documents submitted by the contractors were reviewed/examined thoroughly on the bases of qualifying criteria mentioned/circulated in bidding documents.

3 EVALUATION OF TECHNICAL BIDS

In response to the advertisement for subject project, following Three (03) Bidders submitted their bid proposal against the said project and it was opened on May 23, 2023 at 11:30 AM in the office of Municipal Officer Infrastructure, MC Hafizabad in presence of Procurement Committee as well as bidders/representatives of bidders.

3.1 Ineligible Bidders

After evaluation of all the bid proposals received, only (01) bidder i.e., M/s Telecon Engineering Pvt. Ltd. has been disqualified due to the reasons stated below:

• The bidder did not fulfil the legal mandatory criteria as affidavit of blacklisting was not attached and also failed in qualifying criteria due to which he couldn't obtain qualifying marks. The details of projects provided were related to only general nature and no similar nature or foreign funded projects were completed by the bidder due to which he could not achieve qualifying marks in Experience category and overall, he is disqualified.

3.2 Summary of the evaluation of Eligible Bidders

The summary of evaluation is attached as Annexure-B at the end of this report.

4 RESULTS

The following Two (02) bidders have been found as qualified and responsive on the basis of the evaluation of their technical bid proposals submitted.

These technical bids have been evaluated as per the evaluation criteria provided in the Volume-I of bidding documents. M/s Telecon Eng Pvt. Ltd. did not meet the mandatory and qualifying criteria as he has not attached blacklisting affidavit and has no required similar nature and foreign funded projects and hence, he has been disqualified. M/s Imran Sharif and M/s Four Star Naru have been found as qualified and responsive as they fulfill the qualifying criteria. The technical evaluation is hereby submitted to Employer/Client's Decision to proceed further with the procurement process under Rule 55A leading to financial opening of the bids.
